A four-day pass is also available for purchase at the event show office for \$20. Cost of admission to the boat show does not include parking. A fee for the adjacent Washington Park lots is collected by the Michigan City Parks Department. Air-conditioned shuttles run from nearby lots to the show entrance during event hours.
